DECLARES

- 1) to have read and consciously accepted, in full and without conditions, the Regulations for participation in the photographic treks organized by Delphicaphoto;
- 2) to be aware of the obligations and requirements for containing the COVID-19 epidemic;
- 3) to scrupulously respect the rules indicated in the Regulations for participation in photographic treks organized by Delphicaphoto during the photographic trek, in particular those relating to the containment of the spread of the COVID-19 contagion, and the directives issued by Delphicaphoto;
- 4) to be aware and accept that, in case of violation of the rules indicated in the Regulations for participation in photographic treks organized by Delphicaphoto, they may be excluded from the trek at any time;
- 5) not to be in one or more conditions referred to in art. 52 of the Regulations for participation in photographic treks organized by Delphicaphoto, and therefore of:
 - a) to have the Green Pass (UE digital Covid certificate) that certifies the vaccination against Covid-19, the recovery from Covid-19 in the last six months or the negative result in the rapid antigen test in the last 48 hours or in the molecular test in the last 72 hours;
 - b) not be positive for COVID-19;
 - c) not accuse or show even modest flu symptoms;
 - d) have not had contact with people affected by COVID-19 in the fifteen days prior to the photo trekking;
 - e) not to be positive, at the time of participation in the photo trekking, in the swab for COVID-19;
 - f) have not been in contact for less than fifteen days with people positive to COVID-19, or who show symptoms or who have had contact with people affected by COVID -19 in the fifteen days prior to the photo trekking;
 - g) not have been ordered in precautionary medical isolation;
 - h) not be without the personal protective equipment referred to in art. 54 letter. b) of the Regulations for participation in photographic treks organized by Delphicaphoto, and therefore to be equipped with:
 - I. one or more surgical or FFP2 face masks approved with the CE mark;
 - II. hydroalcoholic-based disinfectant gel according to CE standards;
 - III. a pair of disposable latex or nitrile gloves for emergency situations.
 - i) to be equipped with a plastic bag for the disposal of used PPE and gloves.

**INFORMATION ON THE PROCESSING OF PERSONAL DATA ARTT. 12 AND 13
OF THE GDPR (General Data Protection Regulation) OF THE EUROPEAN UNION
N. 2016/679 - EUROPEAN REGULATION ON THE PROTECTION OF PERSONAL DATA**

Pursuant to the GDPR of the European Union no. 2016/679 the processing of your personal data will be based on principles of correctness, lawfulness, transparency and protection of your privacy and your rights.

Holder of the treatment

The Data Controller of your data is the natural person YLENIA CANTELLO (Via Dante 56, 53100 Siena), hereinafter referred to as Delphicaphoto.

Object of the treatment

Delphicaphoto collects the personal data you provide on the occasion of your participation in the photographic trek organized by Delphicaphoto.

Purposes and legal bases of data processing

Your personal data are processed with your prior consent, for reasons of public interest, for the purposes of applying the anti-contagion security protocols provided for by the legislation and guidelines in force to deal with the epidemiological emergency from COVID-19.

Methods of data processing and scope of data communication

The processing of your personal data is carried out both in paper and computerized form - with technical and organizational methods that ensure a level of security adequate to the risk pursuant to art. 32 GDPR of the European Union no. 2016/679. Your data will not be disclosed or communicated to third parties outside the specific regulatory provisions (for instance in the event of a request by the Health Authority for the reconstruction of the supply chain of any close contacts of a subject who tested positive for COVID-19). Your personal data may be disclosed to public authorities.

Automated decision making and profiling

Your personal data are not transferred abroad and are not processed by automated decision-making processes, nor by profiling activities.

Retention period

Your personal data are kept until the end of the state of emergency provided for by the competent public authorities.

Consequences in case of refusal to collect or provide data

The provision of your personal data for the aforementioned purposes is necessary and mandatory and any refusal to provide such data will make it impossible to participate in the photographic trek. Your personal data will not be disclosed or transferred to non-EU countries.

Rights of the interested party

You have the right to obtain, in the cases provided for, access to your personal data and the correction or cancellation of the same or the limitation of the processing that concerns them or to oppose the processing (articles 15 and following of the GDPR of the European Union n. 2016/679). The appropriate application must be submitted to the Data Controller by sending an e-mail to info@delphicaphoto.com.

If you believe that the processing of your personal data, carried out according to the methods indicated therein, is in violation of the provisions of Regulation (EU) 2016/679, you have the right to lodge a complaint with the Guarantor, as required by art. 77 of the GDPR of the European Union n. 2016/679, or to take the appropriate judicial offices as required by art. 79 of the aforementioned GDPR.
